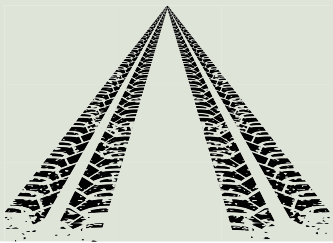
In 2023, Grow Wild built an education trailer to engage and educate the public and advance our conservation message.

The interactive education trailer includes information, graphics, materials related to:

1. Terrestrial & aquatic invasive species
2. Clean recreation practices (Clean.Drain.Dry. and PlayCleanGo)
3. Crail Gardens & Wildscapes (our native demonstration garden in Big Sky and our program promoting the use of native plants in landscapes)

The exterior has engaging graphics and photos, along with logos of our partners and funders. The interior highlights invasive species on one side and native species on the other.
